Thursday 30th July until Sunday 2nd August

Summer camp will be based at Grange Farm Equestrian Centre from Thursday 30th July until Sunday 2nd August. Just like last year we have designed the format to enable riders to "Pick 'n' Mix" which days, half days, instructors and disciplines they want to take part in. Camp is open to members and non members. Riders will have the opportunity of stabling their horse at GFEC either just during the day or on DIY livery. You can also camp overnight.

Each day members can either have 1 or 2 sessions and lunch. All sessions will be run in small groups, with riders of similar ability.

Instruction will be given by regular Academy trainers – Peter Hales, Steph Cooper, Anne Garratt, and Kate Knight.

We will also have 2 guest trainers –

- **Friday 31st August** – Zinnia Welby will be running a Showing Clinic.
- **Sunday 2nd August** – Louise Darrington will be running sessions on Le Trec.

As well as the day time training, we have also organised evening events – Horse First Aid, Intelligent Horsemanship Demonstration and Quiz Night including BBQ.

- *Riders can pick have 1 or 2 session of covering Show Jumping, -Dressage, Showing or Cross Country (ground permitting).*

- Friday 31st July (eve)** - **Intelligent Horsemanship Demonstration by Gary Bosworth – 7pm.**
Demonstration is aimed to show how Intelligent Horsemanship methods can be used to improve your relationship with your horse, improve their behaviour and even solve difficult loaders. Gary Bosworth was recommended to the Academy by Kelly Marks and regularly helps Kelly run courses at her home in Lambourn.
- Saturday 1st August** - **Mixed Discipline.**
- *Riders can have 1 or 2 sessions covering – Show Jumping, Pole work, Dressage, Cross Country.*
- **Trainers** – Kate Knight, Anne Garratt and Steph Cooper.
(Please note – Sessions with Steph Cooper will be in pairs. If there are spaces riders may be able to have 2 sessions or 1 private with Steph but there will be an additional charge. Please indicate your request upon the booking form.)
- Saturday 1st August (eve)** - **7pm - Wittering Academy RC AGM & Prize Giving**
- **7.45pm - BBQ & Quiz**
