Directions: Grange Farm is located 10 miles west of Peterborough ¼ mile off the A47. The turning to Old Oundle Rd is located opposite a stone cottage. Having taken this turn, Grange Farm is located ¼ mile on the right – look out for flag poles and signage boards. Parking will be sign posted once on Grange Farm driveway.

## Rules

1. All classes will run under British Riding Club rules.
2. Declaration forms to be handed to the organiser 30 minutes before the start of the class or competitors will compete HC.
3. We will do our very best to accommodate last minute changes to entries, but please note we will not be able to accept significant changes to teams after 1pm on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June.
4. Flu certificates will be checked in accordance with BRC rules. Failure to produce a valid vet certificate will incur elimination. (Competitors may be allowed to compete HC at the discretion of the organiser.)
5. Competitors must wear correct dress and hard hats complying with the BRC rules at all times when riding. Tack will be checked in accordance with BRC rules and riders will not be allowed to compete if not complying.
6. BRC code of conduct (Rules C1-C3 inclusive) will be strictly followed and any unsportsmanlike conduct or abuse of the horse or pony will be brought to the attention of the Official Steward. Elimination will be enforced.
7. The decisions of the judges and/or organisers are final.
8. Any objection must be made in writing within 30 minutes of closing the class to the Show Secretary accompanied by a deposit of £20 which may be refunded.
9. Dogs are permitted on site but we ask that they are kept on leads at all times and any mess cleaned up.
10. Riding Clubs are respectfully reminded that a preliminary entry means a commitment to pay the area fee.
11. The organisers and land owners will not hold themselves responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever, however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident.
