Most dressage competitions as you know are run by volunteers, and one of the important roles is the position of writer or scribe. The dressage scribe sits with the judge, writing down the scores and comments he/she gives on each test ridden. It is very helpful, particularly if you compete yourself, to see how judges score, what they are looking for, and all in all, a great way to see and learn about dressage, while giving back to the club and beyond. Give it a try, and you'll find it a rewarding experience. All it takes is good listening and fast writing skills.
