Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any prelim class
- Class 2** **BRC HT90Q or BRCHT100Q** (these tests are on our [website](#))
Please state which test you would like to perform; class will be split if enough entries. This does not count as a qualifying class
- Class 3** **Prelim 2 (2016)**
Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any Novice class
- Class 4** **Prelim 18 (2002)**
Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any Novice class
- Class 5** **Novice 24 (2010)**
- Class 6** **Novice 28 (2008)**
- Class 7** **PY0 (E42, E44, M63, M71)**
More than one test can be ridden; Please state on entry form the test(s) you would like to perform
- ROSETTES:** To 6th Place (Juniors/Seniors will be separated if 6 or more juniors otherwise rosette to best junior)
- ENTRY FEES:** £10 Members; £14 Non-members; Late entries £3 extra if space **NO ENTRY WITHOUT PAYMENT**
- ENTRIES:** **ONLINE ENTRIES** via the website (Please note the non-refundable admin charge of £1.50) or complete the form and send with a cheque payable to 'Wittering Academy' to WARC March Dressage, Wittering Grange, Wansford, Peterborough, PE8 6NR
- CLOSING DATE:** **Sunday 17th February** (Late entries until **Tuesday 19th** if space)
- TIMES:** Times will be available on www.witteringacademy.com and Facebook from **Thursday 21st March 8pm** and through the online entry link

Classes will start at 9.30 although we retain the right to alter this due to weather conditions

All classes and warm-up are on all weather surfaces

RULES: Qualification for the Championship Classes (to be held on May 19th, 2019) will be based on the following criteria: Top 6 qualify if score is 60% or over. The qualification will pass down if the score is 60% or over.

NOTE: Riders who qualify in multiple levels (e.g. Prelim & Novice) will only be allowed to compete at the Winter Championships in the highest level achieved. There will only be a separate Junior championship class at any level if there are 6 or more juniors qualified otherwise there will be a championship rosette to the best junior in each class. Juniors are under 18 on 1/9/18. Winners of Championship classes receive a sash and championship rosette and there is also a reserve championship rosette.
