- Class 1** **Intro A (2008) - Lead Rein or Assisted for riders aged 10 and under**
Leader must not speak or have any control of the pony; Callers may use simplified words and repeat instructions if necessary. No other class may be entered. No combination to have previously entered a prelim class.
- Class 1A** **Intro A (2008)**
Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any prelim class
- Class 2** **Intro C (2016)**
Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any prelim class
- Class 3** **Prelim 12 (2005)**
Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any Novice class
- Class 4** **Prelim 18 (2002)**
Restricted to horse/pony combinations not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any Novice class
- Class 5** **Novice 24 (2010)**
- Class 6** **Novice 28 (2008)**
- Class 7** **PYO – Novice 22 (2007), Novice 39 (2010)/Elementary 43 (2006)/Elementary 45 (2010) – long arena**
More than one test can be ridden; Please state on entry form the test(s) you would like to perform;
Class may be split if entries are large

ROSETTES: To 6th Place (Rosette to best junior in each class if not placed)

ENTRY FEES: £10 Members & Rutland riding club members; £14 Non-members; Late entries £3 extra if space **NO ENTRY WITHOUT PAYMENT**
